MINUTES OF MONDAY, FEBRUARY 26, 2007**

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** Motion by Lawrenz second by Meyer to approve agenda as presented. Motion carried.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Motion by Meyer, second by Lawrenz to approve January 29 regular meeting and February 2 Special meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried.

**DEPARTMENT REPORTS:**

**FIRE DEPARTMENT BY CHIEF TOM ACKERMAN, JR.:**

- \* The Department responded to 9 calls, totaling 115.80 "staff hours" since last meeting.
- \* Members completed 4 hour Emergency First Aid Training Course
- \* Several members will participate in Wildland Fire Training March 3-4 in Kewaunee
- \* City is in receipt of check for \$26,261.76 from Town of Pierce for its 2007 Service Contract
- \* 2006 Fire and Rescue Annual Report is completed.
- \* Discussed Walldog Wave proposal. Chairman to obtain answers to several questions Raised and report back

**RESCUE SQUAD BY CAPTAIN KELLY KOSS:**

- \* Responded to 31 calls since last meeting.
- \* Members completed CPR Refresher Training
- \* Members will participate in Basic Refresher and IV Refresher courses from March to May

**POLICE DEPARTMENT BY CHIEF TERRY MAGNO:**

- \* The Dept. responded to 137 calls since last meeting. (shortened period)
- \* A new policy on false alarms was presented. Motion by Lawrenz, second by Meyer to recommend approval of policy to full Council. Motion carried

- \* Several Officers have, and continue to complete various training courses In February and March
- \* SERT Training discussed. 28 students from the Algoma School District are presently participating in the first session of training at the High School. They have been trained in Emergency Response, Emergency Preparedness, Basic Fire Safety, Red Cross First Aid, CPR and Automatic Defib. We have an additional 35 students registered to participate in the second session once it is scheduled.
- \* Damaged Squad was again discussed. Lawrenz suggested that we request two separate repair estimates to completely restore the Squad to its pre-accident condition and then submit the estimates, along with our request to have the Squad repaired to the insurance company for action. City Atty. Blazkovec concurs and indicates that the City could also begin litigation against the driver of the striking vehicle and her insurance company. Chief Magno will arrange for two separate estimates on the Squad.
- \* Chief Magno will discuss Snow Removal Ordinance (8.11) with Public Works Committee because of recent complaints.

- \* Parking Across Sidewalk complaint discussed. There is a City Ordinance (7.340-7.941.03), as well as State Statute (346.52(d), covering such violations. Warnings have been issued to violators to stem problem

- \* Letter from William Kunath, owner of Steelhead Saloon – 430 Fourth St. – was discussed. Mr. Kunath wished to provide the committee with an update as to renovations to the property because the business has not been open during the Class B License Period. Chairman met with Mr. Kunath at the property on February 19 and personally observed the extent of work being undertaken. The owner is making continued progress toward opening. Anticipated opening May 1.

Having no further business, Motion by Lawrenz, Second by Meyer to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:25PM.
