**DEPARTMENT REPORTS:**

**FIRE DEPARTMENT BY CHIEF TOM ACKERMAN:**

- \* Responded to 7 calls totaling 141.87 staff hours since last meeting
- \* A special “thank you” to the volunteers who helped and those who attended the 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Porkie Pancake Breakfast and the Porky Mueller Memorial Motorcycle Ride. Funds raised in the motorcycle ride will be equally divided between the Fire Dept. and two members presently undergoing medical treatments

**RESCUE SQUAD BY CAPT. KELLY KOSS:**

- \* Responded to 23 calls since last meeting
- \* State concluded inspections on both ambulances. Both passed.
- \* Some minor warranty issues were addressed and resolved with the new ambulance

**POLICE DEPARTMENT BY CHIEF MAGNO:**

- \* The Dept. hosted a Drugs That Impair Driving training for several departments
- \* Discussed request for Stop sign on “frontage road” by Schinderle Funeral Home. That street presently goes unnamed. Request will be forwarded to Public Works.

**COMMUNITY SERVICE OFFICERS BY CHIEF MAGNO:**

- \* Gloria Peterson has been appointed to CSO.

**APPROVAL OF DEPARTMENT BILLS:**

**OLD BUSINESS:**

- \* Chairman indicated that Mobile Home Park "Set Back" issue needs further research with city's new Building Inspector. Meeting with City Attorney and Building Inspector will be scheduled

- \* Chief Magno reports that monitoring of traffic patterns near Perry Field does not warrant additional Stop signs at this time. They will continue to monitor.

- \* Discussed information received from Planning Commission re: Conditional Home Occupation Use at 1912 Fremont. Conditional Use was granted by Planning Comm. in February 2003 based upon the plan presented, with a stipulation that the owner was not to work on more than two vehicles not owned by the owner. If there is further complaint it will be investigated by the Police Dept.
