

**PROTECTION OF PERSONS AND PROPERTY COMMITTEE  
MEETING  
MINUTES OF MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2007**

This meeting of the Protection of Persons and Property Committee was called to order at City Hall at 4:01PM by Chairman Scott Ryan at City Hall.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** Motion by Lawrenz, second by Meyer to approve. Carried

**APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:** Minutes were amended to correctly indicate that Kelly Koss was absent and that Rescue minutes were provided by Chief Ackerman. Motion by Lawrenz, second by Schmidt to approve. Carried

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Mr. Salvadore Levy appeared at the direction of the Mayor to discuss his potential to provide Spanish translation services to the Police and Fire Departments. Mr. Levy indicated that he would be available to provide such services 24 hours per day. Chief Magno, Chief Ackerman and Captain Koss do see a need for such services and recommend the approval of Mr. Levy as a Spanish translator. Motion by Lawrenz, second by Meyer to approve the use of Mr. Levy as a Spanish Translator and that if payment for services is requested that the City consider offering an Independent Contractor Agreement for same. All Yes, Motion carried

**DEPARTMENT REPORTS:**

**FIRE DEPARTMENT BY CHIEF TOM ACKERMAN:**

- \* Responded to 9 calls totaling 71.40 staff hours since last meeting
- \* The Department was notified that it did not receive grant funds as applied for with the Assistance to Fire Fighter Grant Program for the replacement of Engine 610.
- \* Annual Pump Tests have begun.
- \* Station Cascade System passed it's Air Quality Test.

**RESCUE SQUAD BY CAPT. KELLY KOSS:**

- \* Responded to 27 calls since last meeting
- \* Naomi Taylor and Mike Swoboda are enrolled in the IV Intermed. Tech. Class
- \* Dr. Sorrells attended last meeting and did a chart review. Discussion will be ongoing relative to how best use Eagle III. County Rescue will attend next meeting to further discuss their perspective on Eagle III usage.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT BY CHIEF MAGNO:**

- \* Department responded to 188 calls since last meeting.
- \* CVR update: Computer Vehicle Registration has reached \$2166.00 in amount received by the City.
- \* DNR indicates that the City cannot enforce “No Fishing” signs inside the Marina. Present signage to that effect should be removed.
- \* Ford Motor Co. indicates that we should have our new Squad by mid-November.
- \* October Training: Kolbeck – DRE (Drug Recognition Expert); Roesch -Front Line Supervisor; Dorner – TRACS, Bloodborne Pathogens

**COMMUNITY SERVICE OFFICERS BY CHIEF MAGNO:**

- \* Gloria Peterson will receive CPR training.
- \* Continue to work “home” Football games

**APPROVAL OF DEPARTMENT BILLS:**

- \* Motion to approve bills as presented by Schmidt; second by Lawrenz  
Roll Call Vote - all yes, motion carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

- \* Chairman indicated that City Atty. has reviewed appropriate Municipal Codes relative to Mobile Home “setbacks” and has rendered the opinion that Ch. 23.24(2) is clear in that there must be a minimum of 10 feet between mobile homes – including unattached accessory buildings, porches, decks, etc. Motion by Schmidt, second by Meyer to have City Attorney draft and forward letter of mobile home park owners explaining the proper “set backs” as described in the Municipal Code and penalties for non compliance. Roll Call vote – All Yes, motion carried.
- \* Winter Parking Regulations were discussed. At this time there will be no change.
- \* Proposed changes to Nuisance Ordinance will be discussed at next meeting.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

- \* Complaint of excessive speed on Hwy. 42 at south City limits was discussed. Chief Magno has discussed the matter with party and recommended they contact the State of Wisconsin to request speed limit changes.
- \* Street light request for 800 block of Ohio was discussed. Motion by Lawrenz, second by Schmidt to approve request. Motion Carried.
