FIRE DEPARTMENT BY CHIEF TOM ACKERMAN:

- * Responded to 6 calls since last meeting
- * Dean Lohrey, Steve Luedke and Don Daul completed 30 hour Entry Level Driver/Operator training and are now State Certified
- * Members volunteered and provided 4 Fire Safety presentations at local schools and Day Care Centers during Fire Prevention Week.
- * Members participated in special training and evaluation using Extrication equipment and Rescue Jacks on October 20.

RESCUE SQUAD BY CAPT. KELLY KOSS:

- * Responded to 27 calls since last meeting
- * Rep. from Eagle III attended last meeting to discuss benefits of using their services more often in lieu of paramedic intercepts. The possibility is being further researched. Cost differences are being evaluated.
- * Renee Zimmerman has completed her 18 month probation period.
Motion by Lawrenz, second by Meyer to grant Regular Member status. All yes.

- * Algoma Rescue has decided not to use the services of Mr. Salvatore Levy for Spanish translation. KCSO has interpreters "on-call" should one be needed.

POLICE DEPARTMENT BY CHIEF MAGNO:

- * Sgt. Roesch completed Front Line Supervisor Class
- * Blood borne Pathogen Class has been rescheduled for 11/27
- * Residential Trick or Treat will be from 4:30pm-6:30pm on October 31 with other festivities to follow at the Youth Club

COMMUNITY SERVICE OFFICERS BY CHIEF MAGNO:

- * Chairman indicated that the City’s Building Inspection Service has been formally requested to inspect appropriate Mobile Home Parks in the City for compliance to the City’s Municipal Code and make report. - * Proposed changes to Nuisance Ordinance. Motion by Schmidt, second by Lawrenz to “Table” matter to November meeting pending further discussion. Motion Carried.
- * Court Testimony Compensation policy was discussed. Further information from Private employers is needed. Motion by Iwen, second by Schmidt to “Table” matter until November meeting pending additional information. Motion Carried

NEW BUSINESS:

- * No Smoking at Perry Field. Ch. 10.15 of Algoma Municipal Code was reviewed at the request of Parks & Rec. Committee.
Motion by Iwen, second by Schmidt to amend present ordinance to indicate that NO SMOKING will be permitted within the Perry Field park complex at any time. (see attached). Motion Carried.
- * Request for “four-way” Stop Sign at Steele & Division was discussed. The committee believes that traffic flow patterns in the area would be negatively affected with such placement. Alternatively, committee recommends trying large warning cone placed in intersection during “events”.
