

**PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD MEETING MINUTES  
SEPTEMBER 22, 2008**

The meeting of the Parks & Rec. Board was called to order on September 22, 2008 at 5:00 PM at the Algoma Youth Club.

Moved by Rodrian second by Ryan to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Moved by Hafeman second by Anderson to approve last month's meeting minutes. Motion carried.

Bills were reviewed. Moved by Anderson second by Hafeman to approve the bills. Motion carried.

Old Business:

- Qualman talked to Kevin Pierre about repairing the flag pole base on HWY 54. Pierre will look at it and get back to the committee.
- The estimate for a new sign at De Meuse Park is approximately \$250.00 - \$300.00 from Jag. Motion by Hafeman second by Anderson to proceed with the purchase of a new sign for De Meuse Park and repainting the signs at Newman Park and Legion Hall Park not to exceed \$600.00. Motion carried.

Director's Report:

- 33 kids participated in the NFL Punt Pass & Kick contest.
- 34 kids signed up for the Flag Football League.
- The post Homecoming party will be at the Youth Club on Saturday, October 11<sup>th</sup>, from Midnight till 3:00AM.
- The Halloween Walk will be held at Peterson Park on Saturday and Sunday, October 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup>.
- Work on Perry Field lights has been completed except for replacing the bulbs.
- A snow fence will again be placed on the beach to stop blowing sand.
- Halloween in Algoma will be held on Friday October 31<sup>st</sup>. Trick or Treat hours are from 4:30 PM-6:30 PM. From 5:00 PM-7:00 PM the Youth Club will be open for grades 3 and lower to enjoy hot dogs, pizza, soda and more. Kids will be able to decorate Halloween cookies, win prizes in the Halloween Fishing Well, play lighting ball, tic tac toe and other games. Kids will also be able to enter the prize drawing for over \$200.00 in prizes. All kids who participate will also receive a bag of treats. For older kids in grades 4 – 12, Rock Que will provide the music from 7:30 PM – 9:30 PM. Halloween flyers will be sent to Algoma schools with the information on the activities. Last year approximately 300 children, teens and parents participated.
