**FIRE DEPARTMENT BY CHIEF TOM ACKERMAN:**

- \* Responded to 5 calls since last meeting
- \* Did not receive Assistance To Firefighters Grant Program money..
- \* Participated in Kewaunee Nuclear Plant Mass Casualty & Hostile Action Training exercise September 10.
- \* Discussed request to use \$3000 from Building Maintenance account to upgrade radios and cover reprogramming charges. This is a safety issue in that Door County Mutual Aid Dept's. have upgraded their radios to new Federal standards and are unable to communicate with our responding units. Motion by Iwen; Second by Lawrenz to "table" the request pending further cost information. Motion carried. As this is not a Building Maintenance issue, the money would also need to come from elsewhere. The committee will discuss this further at our next meeting and make a recommendation.
