Moved by Konkell second by Ryan to adopt the agenda. Motion carried.

Moved by Glime second by Taylor to grant a Conditional Home Occupation to Steve Mocco to do small engine repair. It was stated that the repair would be done between noon and 8:00 p.m. Roll call vote: 9 yes and 0 no. Motion carried.

Moved by Haasch second by Mueller to grant a Conditional Home Occupation for Pet Grooming to Amy Jensen. Roll call vote. 9 yes and 0 no. Motion carried.

Moved by Haasch second by Baumann to allow Glenn Reinle to rent a duplex on short term and daily rentals. Roll call vote. 9 yes and 0 no. Motion carried.

Moved by Ryan second by Taylor to name the frontage road west of Sunset along Hwy 54 Schinderle Lane. Motion carried.

Moved by Glime second by Haasch to formally amend TID #1 project plan with the assistance of Jennifer Brown of Kewaunee County Economic Development and no fee would be charged to the City by KCED. Roll call vote. 8 yes and 1 no. (Taylor) Motion carried.

Moved by Glime second by Bauman to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
