\$500 Public Power Scholarship

Eligibility guidelines

1. High school senior may submit an essay to win a **\$500** scholarship. The student (or their parent or legal guardian) must be a customer of **Algoma Utilities**. Dependents of utility personnel are not eligible.
2. High school senior must plan to attend a two-year technical college or a four-year university.
3. Essays should be on the theme: ***The Value of Renewable Energy in Kewaunee County.*** Essays should be between 500 and 1,000 words — typed and double-spaced — and include the following information on the cover:
 - Student's first and last name
 - Home address
 - Phone number
 - Name of parent or legal guardian
 - Utility account information (Name on account; billing address; account number)
4. Deadline for submitting essays is **April 18, 2008**. Please submit all essays and the completed application form below to Algoma Utilities office.
