

**MINUTES  
CEMETERY COMMISSION  
FEBRUARY 1, 2005**

The Cemetery Commission met on February 1, 2005 at 3:00 PM at City Hall.

Present: Ken Taylor, Tom Ackerman, Tom Romdenne

Also present: Jason Wiese, Gary Paape

Moved by Ackerman second by Romdenne to adopt the agenda. Motion carried.

No public comment. No bills.

The Cemetery regulations brochure will be placed in a box located near the Chaple. Signs will be posted at the entrances directing people to the chapel area to obtain copies of the Cemetery regulations.

Taylor will contact an electrician regarding lighting of the American Flag. Lights will be placed on the flagpole. This will eliminate obstruction on the ground and no protective barrier will be needed.

Jason Wiese will lay out Block 7 of the Busch Plat using the 40' block pattern with 6' walkways similar to the other cemetery blocks.

Evergreens will be planted on the west side of the Chapel. Trees will be purchased from Krause Tree Farm.

The Street Dept will look at specific trees in the cemetery that should be removed because they are a maintenance issue or a safety issue.

The remainder of the roads in the cemetery will be seal coated when Scott Construction is in town for other work. A firm price will not be available until June.

Ground maintenance will be done as it was in 2004. Cemetery staff will be contacted regarding ground maintenance.

Public Works may be replacing a pickup truck. The truck currently at the WWTF would be given to the cemetery as a result of truck rotation at Public Works.

Moved by Romdenne second by Ackerman to adjourn. Motion carried.
