Community Development Committee Minutes
August 17, 2009

The regular meeting of the Community Development Committee was called to order by the chairman at 6:10 p.m. on Monday, August 17th, 2009, at City Hall. Present were Bruce Charles (chairman), Kevin Schmidt, Dave Wood, Tina Marie Kazmierczak and Russ Ritchie. Jodi Zimmerman, Diana Baker, Paula Levy and Mike Glime were absent. Also present was Tom Romdenne.

Moved by Kevin, second by Tina: to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

There was no public input.

Moved by Kevin, second by Dave: to approve the minutes of the July 20th regular meeting. Motion carried.

The financial report was reviewed. There was one bill to pay.

Moved by Russ, second by Kevin: to approve the bill. Motion carried.

Dave reported for the Business Park Development Subcommittee that the DNR approved the plan for the new business park. The preliminary plat is finished and a corresponding cost estimate will be completed in time for the next Planning Commission meeting. A zoning proposal for the property is also being prepared.

Bruce reported for the Beautification Subcommittee that he discussed with Chief Magno the complaint procedure for properties in violation of public nuisance ordinance. Any citizen may write a letter to the police outlining a violation and requesting remedial action.

Rotting algae on the beach was discussed. The DNR currently prohibits the city from removing the algae, but is looking into a solution.

There was no Waterfront Development Subcommittee report.

The 2010 CDC budget was reopened for review. With Tom's help, accommodation tax expenditures for 2010 were folded into the budget and a revised budget proposed.

Moved by Russ, second by Dave: to approve the revised 2010 CDC budget. Motion carried. The budget will be submitted to the Common Council for approval.

There was no new business. There were no extra-committee activity reports.

Moved by Kevin, second by Tina: to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
