A meeting of the Ad Hoc Ferry Boat Committee was called to order by the chairman at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, September 7th, 2010, at City Hall. Present were Ken Taylor (chairman), Gini Haske, Bruce Charles, Tom Levy, Jason Wiese, Kevin Naze and Russ Ritchie

The continuing need for a feasibility study was discussed. The committee talked about the scope of the study, how to identify potential vendors and how to fund the study. Individual members of the committee will pursue each of these questions and report to the committee.

The Community Development Committee will be approached for initial assistance in funding the feasibility study. Using funds from the Dettman Estate earmarked for the waterfront was also discussed.

There were no further updates from our representatives in Washington, D.C. The committee was hopeful that some of the political barriers to this project will be removed in November.

The members of the ad hoc committee reaffirmed their commitment to bring a cross-lake ferry boat to the City of Algoma.
