

**Algoma Public Works Committee
Meeting Minutes of September 29, 2009**

The Algoma Public Works Committee met on September 29, 2009 at 5:00PM at the City Garage.

Moved by Nell second by Schmidt to adopt the amended agenda. Motion carried.

Moved by Ryan second by Nell to approve previous month's minutes. Motion carried.

Norb Dier appeared to inquire if there are funds for cutting in Dier Ave in the 2010 budget. The Committee stated the funds were recommended in their budget.

The Committee opened the bids for snow removal. Three bids were received. Two were by the hour and one was based on various snowfall events. Moved by Nell second by Ryan to table any award until the Street Superintendent can cost out the bids. Motion carried.

Mary Derozier appeared to request a sewer credit for lawn watering. She was told by Utility that her lawn watering did not meet the current Utility guidelines for watering and receipt of credit. There was no action taken on the request because of a lack of a motion.

Moved by Schmidt second by Ryan to approve the bills for WWTF and Street Dept. Motion carried.

The digester cover project at the WWTF has been completed. The spent backwash system upgrade has been delayed because of a pump warranty issue. 408,000 gallons of bio-solid have been field-spread.

The alley surface on the alley between Steele and State Streets/6TH and 7th Streets has been removed and grass has been planted. Leaf pickup will start around October 19th. The lighting at the WWTF will start with the outside light and the control building.

The State Street culvert pipe project has been denied by the DNR. The City has the right of appeal to the State. This avenue will be pursued.

Moved by Ryan second by Schmidt to approve one sewer credit. Motion carried.

The final bill on the 6th & Ohio Project will be ready for the October meeting.

Moved by Schmidt second by Ryan to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:14 PM.
