

**ALGOMA CLEAN-UP
MAY 4, 2009**

**THE ANNUAL RESIDENTIAL CLEAN-UP WILL BE HELD MONDAY, MAY 4TH.
PLEASE NOTE THERE WILL BE NO FALL CLEAN-UP.**

THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS APPLY:

1. ALL RUBBISH AND REFUSE MUST BE BAGGED OR BOXED AND PLACED IN AN ORDERLY FASHION AT THE CURB. NO PICKUP IN ALLEYS OR ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.
NOTE: NO LOOSE MATERIAL WILL BE PICKED UP AND WEIGHT LIMIT OF BOXES OR BUNDLES IS 70 POUNDS.
2. LEAVES, GRASS, LAWN DEBRIS IN GENERAL WILL NOT BE PICKED UP. THESE THINGS SHOULD BE TAKEN TO THE COMPOST PILE BEHIND THE CITY GARAGE.
3. SCRAP METAL, STOVES, WASHERS, DRYERS SHOULD BE IN A SEPARATE PILE.
ANY PIPE, IRON OR METAL MUST NOT EXCEED 4' IN LENGTH.
4. LARGE ITEMS SUCH AS FURNITURE AND OTHER HOUSEHOLD ITEMS SHOULD ALSO BE IN A SEPARATE PILE. CARPETING MUST BE CUT, ROLLED AND TIED IN PIECES NOT WIDER THAN 4'.
5. APPLIANCES WITH REFRIGERATION UNITS (REFRIGERATORS, DEHUMIDIFIERS, AIR CONDITIONERS, FREEZERS, ETC) **WILL NOT BE PICKED UP UNLESS FREON HAS BEEN RECLAIMED AND THE APPLIANCE HAS BEEN TAGGED.** ANOTHER OPTION FOR UNITS WITH FREON IS TO TAKE THEM TO THE KEW CTY LANDFILL – CHARGE IS \$20.
6. **ITEMS AND MATERIAL THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP:
TIRES, PAINT, POISON, BALLASTS, FLUORESCENT TUBES, BRICKS, STONES, CONCRETE AND CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS.**

TO ENSURE A SUCCESSFUL PICK-UP PLEASE ADHERE TO THE GUIDELINES AND PLACE ITEMS AT THE CURB IN SUCH A WAY AS TO ALLOW EASE OF HANDLING.

ITEMS MAY BE PLACED CURBSIDE BEGINNING THURSDAY, APRIL 30TH BUT NOT LATER THAN 6:00 AM MONDAY, MAY 4TH.

PLEASE NOTE THAT RECYCLABLES AND GARBAGE SHOULD BE SET APART FROM OTHER MATERIALS WHEN CLEAN-UP DAY IS ON A GARBAGE DAY.
