

**PLANNING COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**JUNE 4, 2009**

The Planning Commission of the City of Algoma was called to order by Mayor Haske at 6:00PM on June 4, 2009 at City Hall.

Moved by Wiese second by Mueller to adopt the agenda. Motion carried.

An inquiry was made relating to using a portion of a residential unit for a chiropractic office. Per the zoning code and building inspector, 25% of the residence can be used for a home office. Therefore there was no action required by the Commission.

The Commission discussed the issue of peddler's permits for sales on public property. The Commission felt that anyone requesting to sell products need to follow the ordinance regarding peddlers permits.

Moved by Wiese second by Schmidt that the City not become involved in moving grave sites that are located on private property. Motion carried.

Moved by Wiese second by Schmidt to provide the Postal Service with the house numbers to be assigned to properties created by newly platted areas within the City limits. Motion carried.

Joe Wiese discussed building permits and asked the Commission to consider not charging a fee for maintenance – type permits. This matter was referred to the Finance Committee for consideration.

Moved by Schmidt second by Mueller to adjourn. Motion carried.
