# **2024 Dog Licenses**

According to State Statute and City of Algoma Municipal Code of Ordinances, all dogs must be licensed annually. 2024 licenses are available after December 08, 2023. Licenses can be applied for at the City Clerk's Office. A current rabies certificate from your Veterinarian is required when applying for the license. Fees are as follows:



Unaltered Dogs \$10.00 Spayed or Neutered \$ 5.00 Kennel License \$35.00

Late fee of \$10 per dog applied after March 31<sup>st</sup>. Per City Ordinance, a fine may be imposed by the Police Department if an unlicensed animal is picked-up and held at our local pound.
